

"Horia Hulubei" National Institute for Research and Development in Physics and Nuclear Engineering (IFIN-HH) would like to inform you that, as of May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018 the EU 2016/679 Regulation on the processing of personal data and the free circulation of those data entered into force (Regulation). IFIN-HH aligns with this Regulation and shall provide the following pieces of information below related to the organisation of the Carpathian Summer School of Physics 2018 (CSSP18).

The processing of personal data mainly aims the promotion and the smooth carrying out of CSSP18 and also the provision of the safety of people and goods. The following personal data are processed: name, first name, series and number of your ID/passport, name of employer, position, email address, country, and phone number as well as other data collected upon your registration and participation in the event. IFIN-HH collects the personal data voluntarily provided, as hard copy or electronic format, as well as pieces of information made available from public sources.

During the event, the organiser shall take photos and video recordings in which participants may be recognised. The organiser may use those materials in electronic format (for the webpage of the event, the websites and Facebook pages of the institute) or by mail (for posters). In agreement with the Regulation, an agreement will be asked from the participants.

IFIN-HH does not disclose or transfer your data to third parties. By exception, IFIN-HH may transfer those data if the legislation in force imposes so, in order to fulfil a task which serves a public interest, the protection and capitalization of the interests of the people concerned and by virtue of ensuring the legitimate interest. In order to publish the compendia in the Proceedings volume, the full names will be transferred to American Institute of Physics.

"An information note" on the processing of personal data, as well as the consent on the taking of photographs and video recordings during the event has been drafted. You may find it attached here and it shall also be included in the folder of the event. Please read it carefully, fill it in and submit it to the organisers at the reception desk before the start of the event. Your presence in the area where the event will take place and having read the "Information note" will be considered as implicit acceptance of its content.

The regulation grants you the following rights: the right to information; the right of access to personal data; the right to rectify personal data; the right to delete personal data (the "right to be forgotten"); the right to restrict the processing; the right to portability of personal data; the right to opposition; the right not to be subject to an individual decision and the right to address the authorities/ justice system.

Each request will be reviewed and you will be informed on the actions taken in that respect, by complying with the provisions of the Regulation.
